



Application for Intern Position with SBAI

Candidates interested in applying for supervision for BACB certification must meet the following criteria:

- Have worked as a Behavioural Interventionist (BI) with 3 SBAI Independent consultants, at least one team with either SBAI director (Sharon Baxter or Claire Egan) for a minimum of 1 year.
- Commit to working with a minimum of 3 SBAI independent consultants, including joining at least one team with either SBAI director (Sharon Baxter or Claire Egan).
- Work a minimum of 20 hours per week with SBAI clients.
- Attend the monthly group supervision meetings.
- Accept supervision feedback and submit to performance evaluations.
- Complete the Intake Review and agree to each condition specified in the review.
- Sign an SBAI contract.

Please note that ongoing involvement with SBAI and signing off on supervision hours is performance contingent. Each Supervisor reserves the right to refrain from signing supervision hours if minimum criteria are not met.
